The stylized floral design is typical of the Aesthetic movement. The Mintons China Works catalog of ca. 1885 described this design as a pattern "of the New Patent "MOROCO" Tiles [which] may be done in all tints of Colour. The surface being Granulated and *expand* [+]
