Description:

Pearlware jug made and printed in puce at the Herculaneum Pottery, Toxteth, Liverpool. The print of the farmyard is one found on 18th century wares, and bears the faint signature of Joseph Johnson. This Liverpool printer seems to have died in

1805, too early to have printed this jug. The Herculaneum Pottery must therefore have acquired his engraved copper-plate and continued to use it,

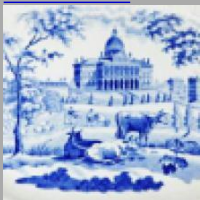
