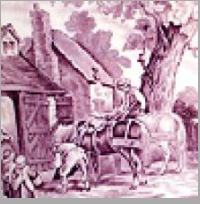

A cylindrical shaped mug printed in blue with blue ground filled-in and enameling overglaze. While similar to the Elephant and Camel pattern produced by Baggerley & Ball, it varies in details and quality. The rider on the elephant is much more predominant in this pattern. "No. 18" in the mark refers to the pattern number. See below for a panoramic view of the design.
