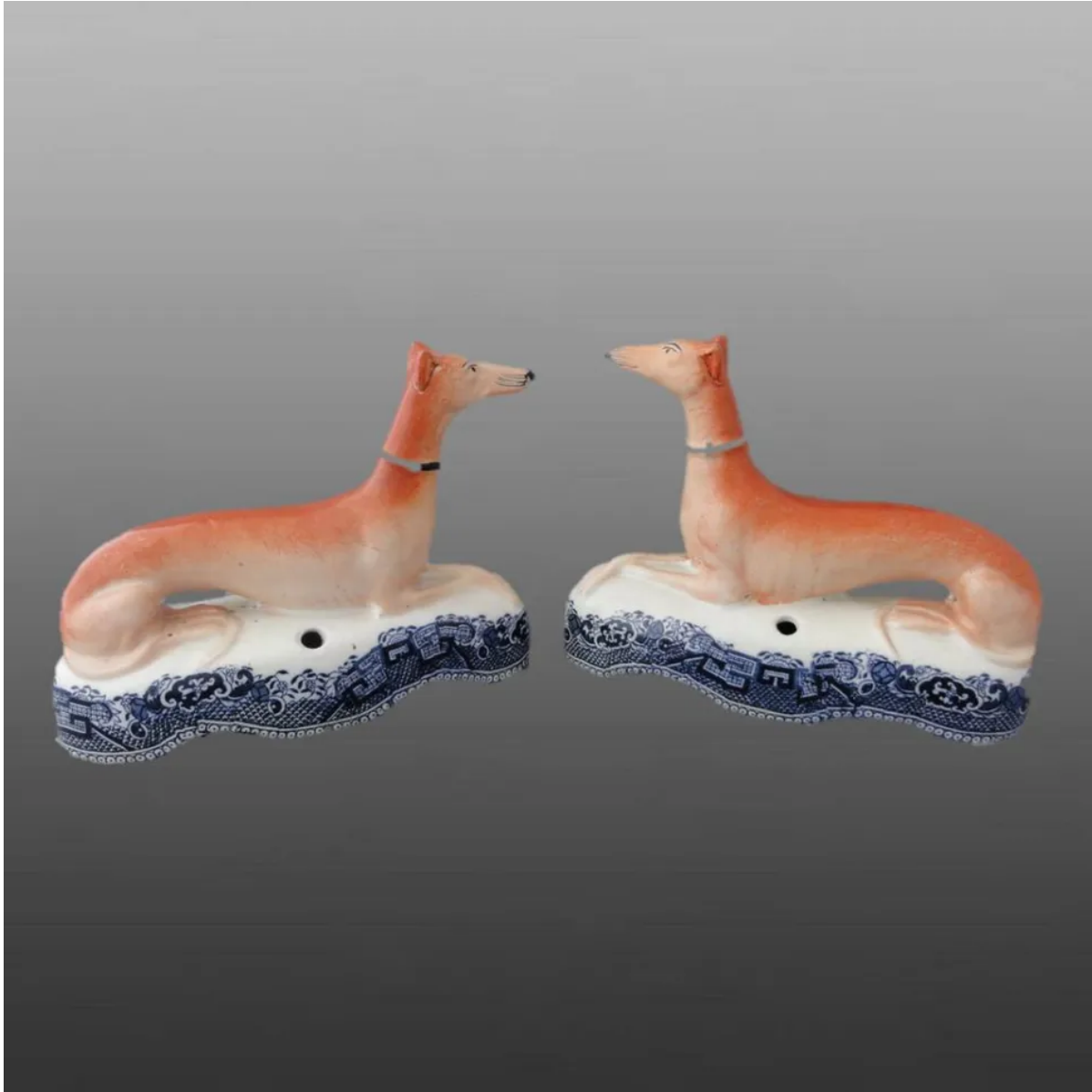

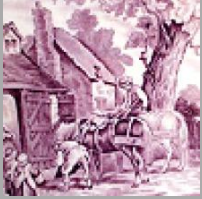

examples of fully painted quill stands can still be found today, examples with a printed base are seldom seen and are considered

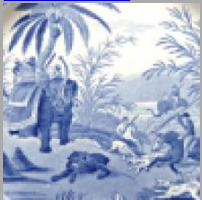
